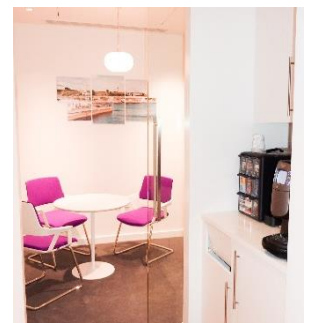

The brief was to create a new 'pop in Centre' and provide a fresh, bright, welcoming environment for service personnel, veterans and their families to get practical help and advice. From conception of the project, Creative Construction worked closely with the architects to deliver what was once an empty shell to a new eye catching and vibrant vicinity.

The facilities included a new entrance, welcome area, various meeting rooms and office space, kitchenettes and bathrooms. Due to the nature of the building sound proofing was a key factor. Refurbishment included: new partitions, wall finishes, internal doors, glazed screens and partitions, floor finishes, ceiling systems, platform lift, new staircase, decoration, bathrooms, tea point and upgrading of services including complete Mechanical & Electrical design and installation.
